



## **Escaroupim Tour**

### **Casa Cadaval / Escaroupim Village / boat tour / Royal Falconry**

Escaroupim, the fishing village. Its origin is in the migration of the fishermen of Vieira de Leiria, who to flee the rigorous winter by the Sea, created campaigns of Winter next to the river Tagus. Many stayed and left this legacy.

A pleasant boat trip on the river Tagus, where, in addition to fish and birds, we can find horses in freedom on an island in the middle of the Tagus.

And also the art of Falconry, Intangible Heritage of Humanity, the noblest of the hunting arts.

## **Tour Description**

In the morning visit Cadaval House, formerly inhabited by Queens, Counts and Countess, with a secular history and belonging to the Cadaval family, where we will visit the Cellar and taste some of its wonderful wines. As an extra option, we can take a tour in the farm and an equestrian baptism (included in the price of 135 euros)

We continue to Aldeia do Escaroupim, the fishing village. Here we will have lunch and go on a pleasant boat trip on the river Tagus where, in addition to fish and birds, we can find horses in an island in the middle of the Tagus.

At the end of the tour, if time permits, we will continue to Salvaterra de Magos to visit Falcoaria Real.
